RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know has experienced or is experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, Stanford University encourages you to seek professional guidance and support and to report the unwanted and unlawful behavior to law enforcement.

HOW TO REPORT

Stanford University offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. It is possible to make an anonymous report.
